**COME ON IN** Ring in the season with a simple-to-make take on the classic evergreen wreath. A few blue spruce boughs are tied with twine and adorned with dozens of little bells for a pretty sound on otherwise silent nights. The satin bow comes together without fuss—loops of ribbon are wired in place, no tying required.
