2. Since 1950s, **Fabricut** has been known for its range of fabrics, trimmings, hardware, wallcoverings, and other accessories for the home. Now they've debuted a line of furniture, with a notable example being the Marielle bench. fabricut.com

3. **Aidan Gray** presents its Cubist Ballet Slipper pink table lamp, wrapped in a soft ballet slipper pink faux leather, ringed with a durable stainless steel base, and equipped with an artfully illumined Edison bulb. aidangrayhome.com

4. The Cirql Collection lounge chair in ginger, designed by Werner Aisslinger, is made of **Dedon** fiber, woven over a powder-coated aluminum frame. Based on round, inviting shapes and a sophisticated geometric woven pattern, Cirql is iconic and alluring. dedon.de

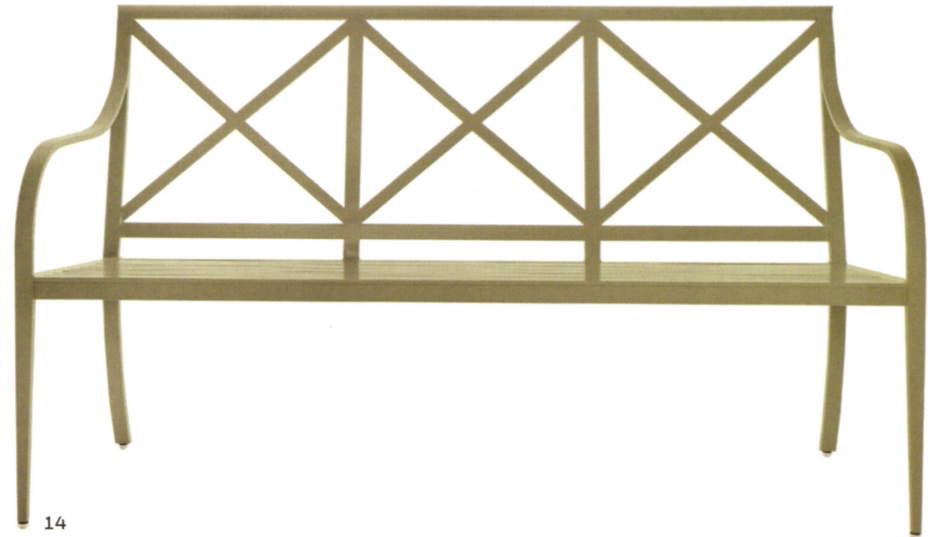
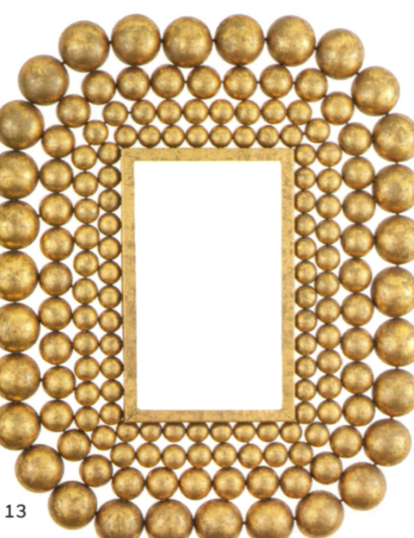
5. Whether you wish to display books, a special collection of decorative plates, or other objects, the Stratton Etagère—Size I, from **latesta Studio**, is the perfect item for your home. Available in custom sizes and finishes. davidiatesta.com

6. Few pieces of furniture can accomplish as much as the Odense II sofa, from **Alfonso Marina**, with its supremely elegant profile. Minimalist in form, but rich in effect. It measures 83" w. x 38" d. x 38" h. alfonsomarina.com

7. This carved modern marble figure, in resting form, manages to be both abstract and representational at the same time. It's a work of art certainly open to interpretation. Available at **C'est Si Bon**. mycestsiBon.com

8. **Sutherland's** Neo-Contour chaise, designed by Jean-Pierre Geelen, evokes some of the most iconic mid-century Modern forms, though this item is decidedly a design of today. It is sinuous, comfortable, and sculptural in presence. sutherlandfurniture.com

9. Wooden likenesses of cow heads are mounted outside abbatoids throughout Austria. This replica, available at **Pennoyer Newman**, assumes a noble and yet whimsical presence in your home, inside or out. pennoyernewman.com



10. Montgomery Place, adjacent to Bard College's main campus, is one of the Hudson Valley's most impressive estates. And **Munder Skiles** designed this chair, in Odessa Pink, based on a chair in that historic house. There is also a bench and tea table in the collection. munder-skiles.com

11. Sometimes the most minimalist forms have the strongest sculptural effect in a room, as evidenced by this Bunni concrete side table from **Teak Warehouse**. It's among the most durable items you can have at home. teakwarehouse.com

12. The colors, forms, and sheer vibrancy of the Decalcomania Palm Beach lamp from **Rosanna Lonsdale** evokes the Florida locale. It comes with a large ivory silk lampshade, with all parts handmade in England. rosannalonsdale.com

13. Moroccan motifs work in virtually every home interior. The **Ro Sham Beaux** Casablanca mirror is defined by its rectangular form, featuring a gold-leaf finish with an intriguing—some might say hypnotic—decorative ball pattern. ro-sham-beaux.com
