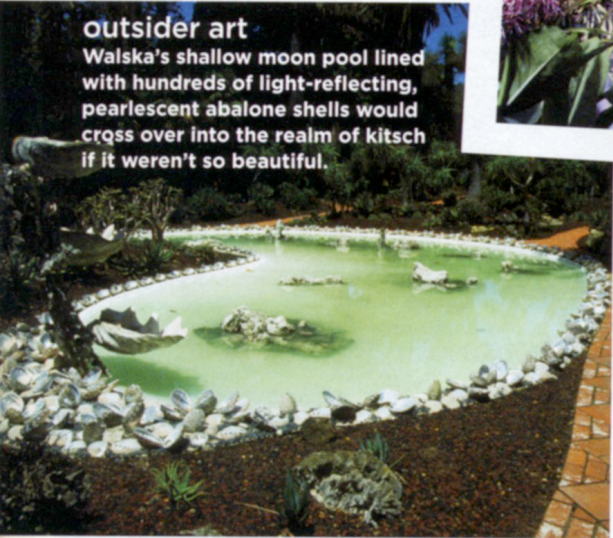
madame ganna walska
