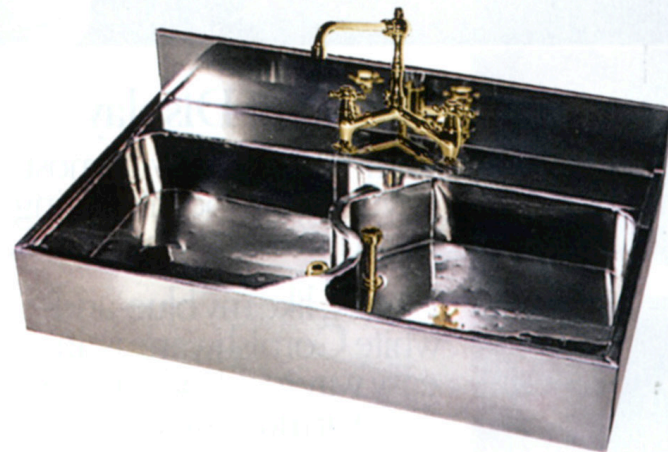

THE LOOK KITCHEN OF THE MONTH

English and French pottery, a German silver sink...You don't have to leave home to bring the European countryside into your kitchen.



1. Since 1920, the T.G. Green pottery in England has been making **CORNISHWARE** the same way—a thin layer of blue clay is put over a white body and then cut away to create stripes. From \$33, available through **PENHALIGAN'S OF ELORA**: 519-846-2356; www.penthaligans.ca.

2. A **COW BUST**, \$100, just like the ones outside European butcher shops, but made of lightweight, weather-resistant resin stone. **PENNOYER NEWMAN**: www.pennynewman.com.

3. Originally made in Germany in the 1880s, the **GERMAN SILVER SINK**, with its plate-friendly S-curve, is not really silver, but a soft, lustrous alloy of copper, nickel, and zinc. Gentle on china and crystal. Standard 42" long, 25" wide, 6" deep. Prices vary. **GERMAN SILVER SINK CO.**: 970-242-4977; www.germansilversink.com.

4. Anything would look great on this limed mango wood **FARMHOUSE SHELF**, 36" by 12" with black iron brackets, \$99. **AMERICA RETOLD**: 518-822-0100; www.americaretold.com.
